

Tax Commissioner Announces New Tag Office Schedule Effective July 1

(Lawrenceville, Ga. June 5, 2017) Tax Commissioner Richard Steele announced that effective July 1 all Gwinnett tag offices will follow a five-day, 8am - 5pm schedule.

There will also be a change in the location offering Saturday services. Beginning July 1, the Lawrenceville tag office will be open on Saturdays, and the North Gwinnett tag branch in Buford will be closed on Saturdays.

“With our Saturday crowds, we have simply outgrown our North Gwinnett location,” explained Richard Steele. “Saturday hours in Lawrenceville will offer Gwinnett County residents a centrally located branch with ample parking as well as drive-thru service. The new five-day schedule also allows for each tag office to be open an additional day each week.”
