## **Snellville Tag Office Closing for Repairs**

LAWRENCEVILLE, Ga., July 8, 2024 – The Gwinnett County Tax Commissioner’s Snellville Tag Office, located at 2845 Lenora Church Road, will be closed Wednesday, July 24 until Monday, July 29 for repairs to a water main break.

Customers can access all DMV services at the GCTC’s other tag locations: Lawrenceville, North Gwinnett, Norcross and Peachtree Corners. The tag offices are open from 8:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. Operating hours extend to 6 p.m. on Wednesdays. Customers can find locations for the tag offices and conduct a range of DMV services at [www.gwinnetttaxcommissioner.com](http://www.gwinnetttaxcommissioner.com). Online services include tag renewal, change of address and canceling a registration.

Individuals also have the option to renew their vehicle registration and get their tag in hand at one of 12 kiosks in the county, including two 24-hour kiosks at the Lawrenceville and North Gwinnett tag office locations. The kiosk housed in Publix at 3550 Centerville Highway in Snellville is the closest to the Snellville Tag Office. It is available during the store’s operating hours. The kiosks accept debit and credit cards. There is a small convenience fee to use a kiosk.

Serving also as an agent for the state of Georgia, the tax commissioner registers and titles motor vehicles and disburses associated revenue. As of December 31, 2023, the GCTC has registered the highest number of motor vehicles in the state.*
